School Bullying and Migration: European Insights from Educational Acts and Prevention Programmes

Schools face challenges ensuring safety, inclusion, and bullying prevention in increasingly diverse classrooms. Children with migrant backgrounds are at a higher risk of victimization and school bullying due to migrant status, adaptation to the new culture, language barriers, different cultural ethnicity, race, and religious backgrounds. Current research lacks comparative cross-national studies on educational legislation and preventive measures addressing school bullying among children with migrant backgrounds. In this lecture I will present two European projects focused on school bullying and migration and discuss data obtained from an analysis of six educational acts and 31 antibullying programs related to migrant children in six European countries: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Germany, Moldova, Norway, and Turkey.

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
