Page layout:

- Size: A4 (21 x 29.7 cm)
- Orientation: Portrait
- Margins: Normal 2.54 cm on all sides

Paragraph properties: Spacing - Before and After – 0 pt  
Line spacing – single

Text (fonts, effects, size):

- Title: 14 pt bold, Calibri, centred
- Author names: 12 pt, Calibri, centred
- Affiliation: 11 pt italic, Calibri, left
- Author email: 11 pt Calibri, left
- Abstract body: 12 pt Calibri, justified
- Figures: Reference in the text as Figure 1  
Figures should be placed within anchored frames
- Figure caption: *Figure 1. 12 pt Calibri Italic*
- References: 10 pt Calibri, justified, hanging indent 1 cm
